



2003-2004 Community Fund Grant Awards

- ❑ 46 programs sponsored by 29 agencies received grant awards totaling \$220,000.
- ❑ 70 grant applications from 42 agencies were received, with requests totaling \$521,080.
- ❑ Largest grant award is \$12,500 to the EOC's Quality Child Care Training program.
- ❑ Smallest grant award is \$1,000 to the AIDS Support Network's Hep C Transportation program.
- ❑ More than 60 community volunteers helped review applications, make site visits and evaluate Community Fund grant applications.
